Important: The 2000 Population for Legislative Districts is derived based on the assignment of voting districts (precincts) to legislative districts as provided by Local Boards of Elections. In a few instances voting districts may not conform exactly to the legislative district boundaries as adopted in 1991. In those instances the closest alternative census feature is used to define the voting district boundary.
