\*\* At least once every ten (10) years, each planning commission shall review the comprehensive plan and, if necessary, revise or amend the comprehensive plan, pursuant to Section 1-416 of the Land Use Article. Additionally, to the extent practicable, this schedule includes a flexible range in years to allow a local jurisdiction to access certain U.S. Census data at the beginning of the comprehensive plan review process. In general, this schedule provides commencement of the plan review process one year prior, and two years after, the ten-year adoption anniversary.
